FLOAT FISHING: Rainbow, German brown, cutthroat, and brook trout are the catch awaiting you aboard your guided boat. We do promote catch and release and can clean any fish you wish to keep, up to your limit. All fly or spin rods and transportation is included. Licenses are an additional cost of \$5.25 and can be provided by Nova. Any lost flies and lures are \$3 each.
